1. We need residents willing to let our study place mosquito traps in their yard from June to October 2023.
2. We will be collecting a finger-prick blood sample from residents at the beginning and end of the mosquito season. This dried blood spot will be tested for West Nile virus antibodies to identify non-symptomatic infection over the 2023 mosquito season.
